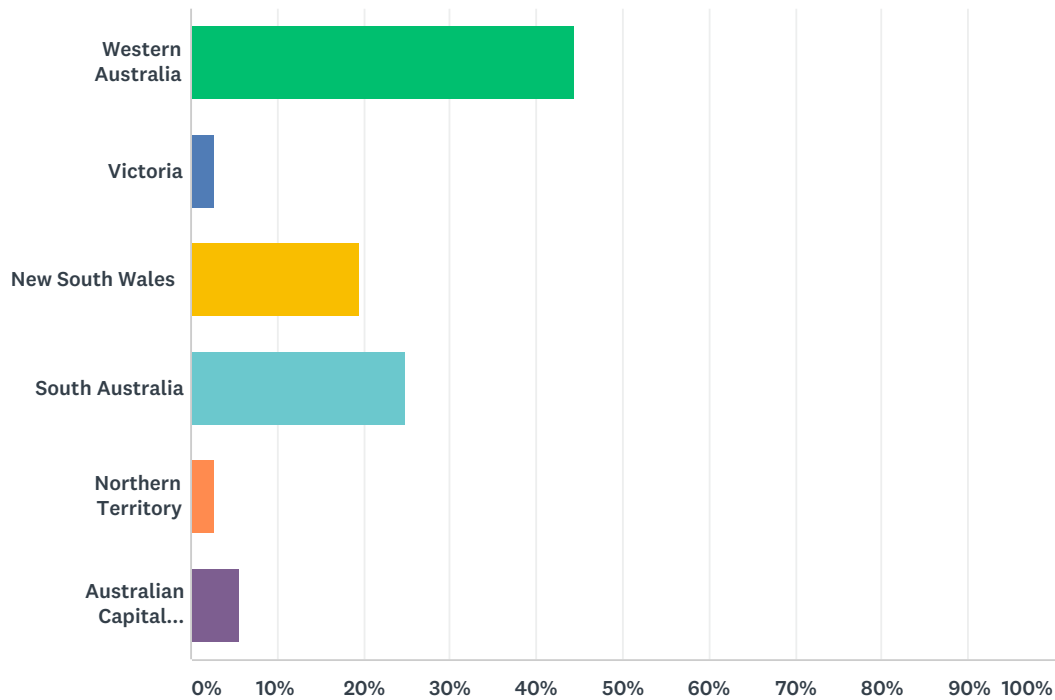


Q1 In which State of Australia are you located?

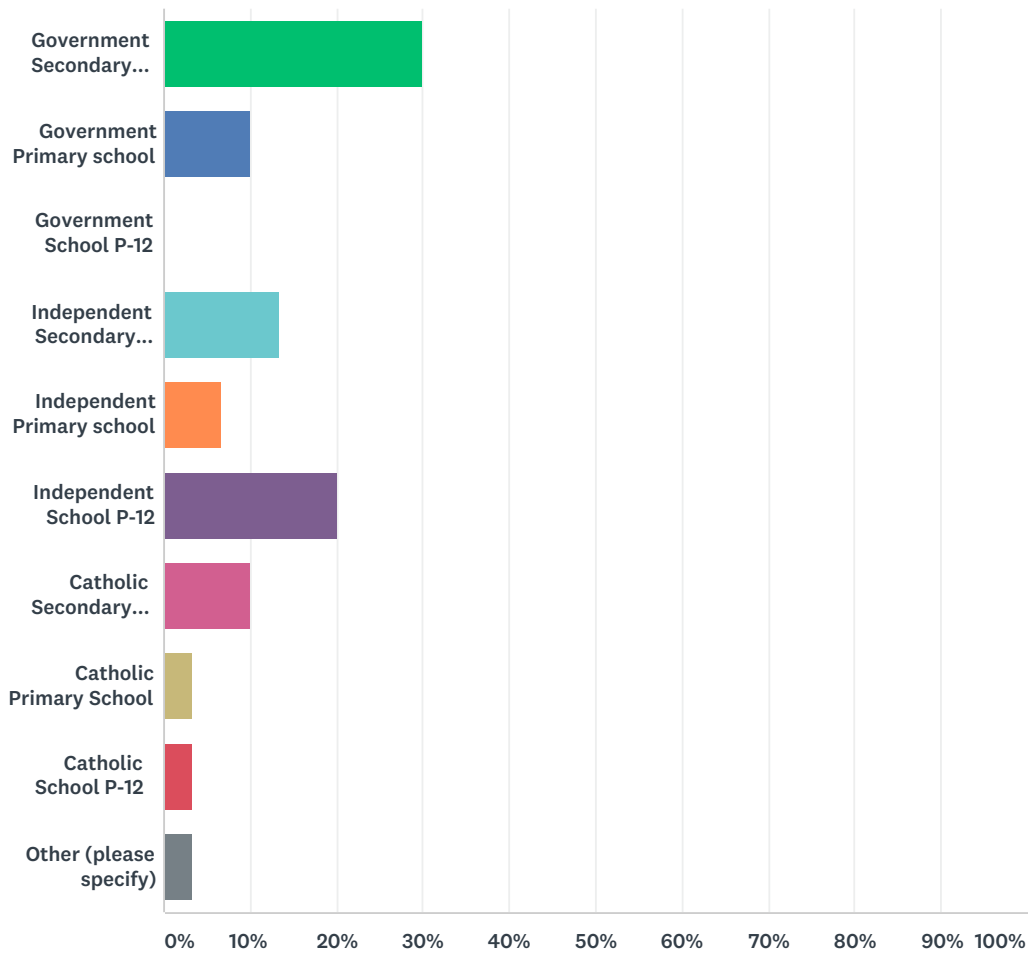

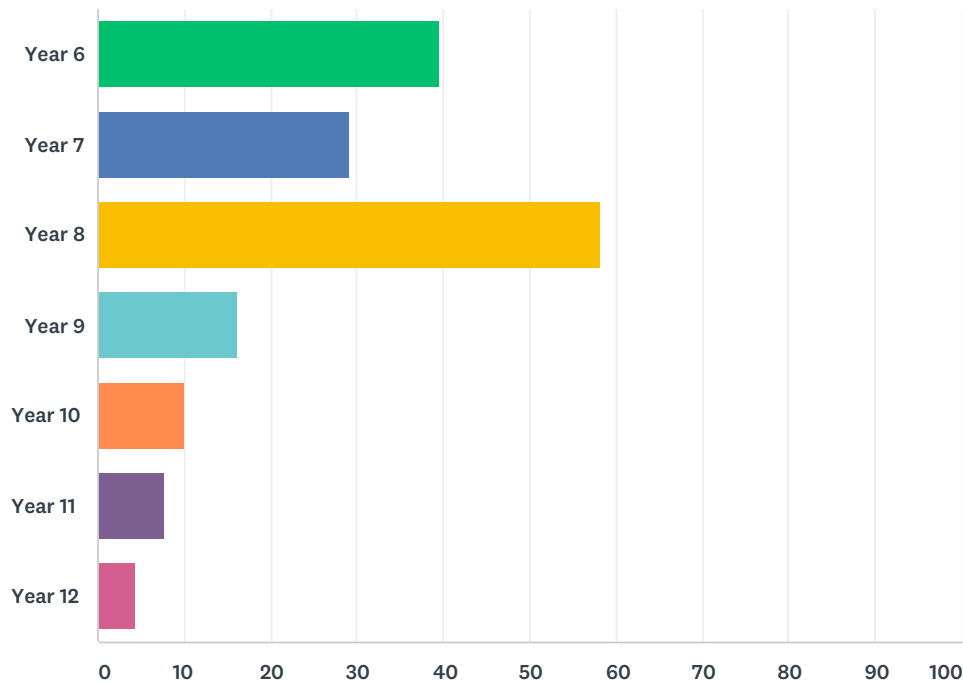

Q6 Please indicate which event/s your students attended during the BBIP's Michael J School Concerts in Oz Tour

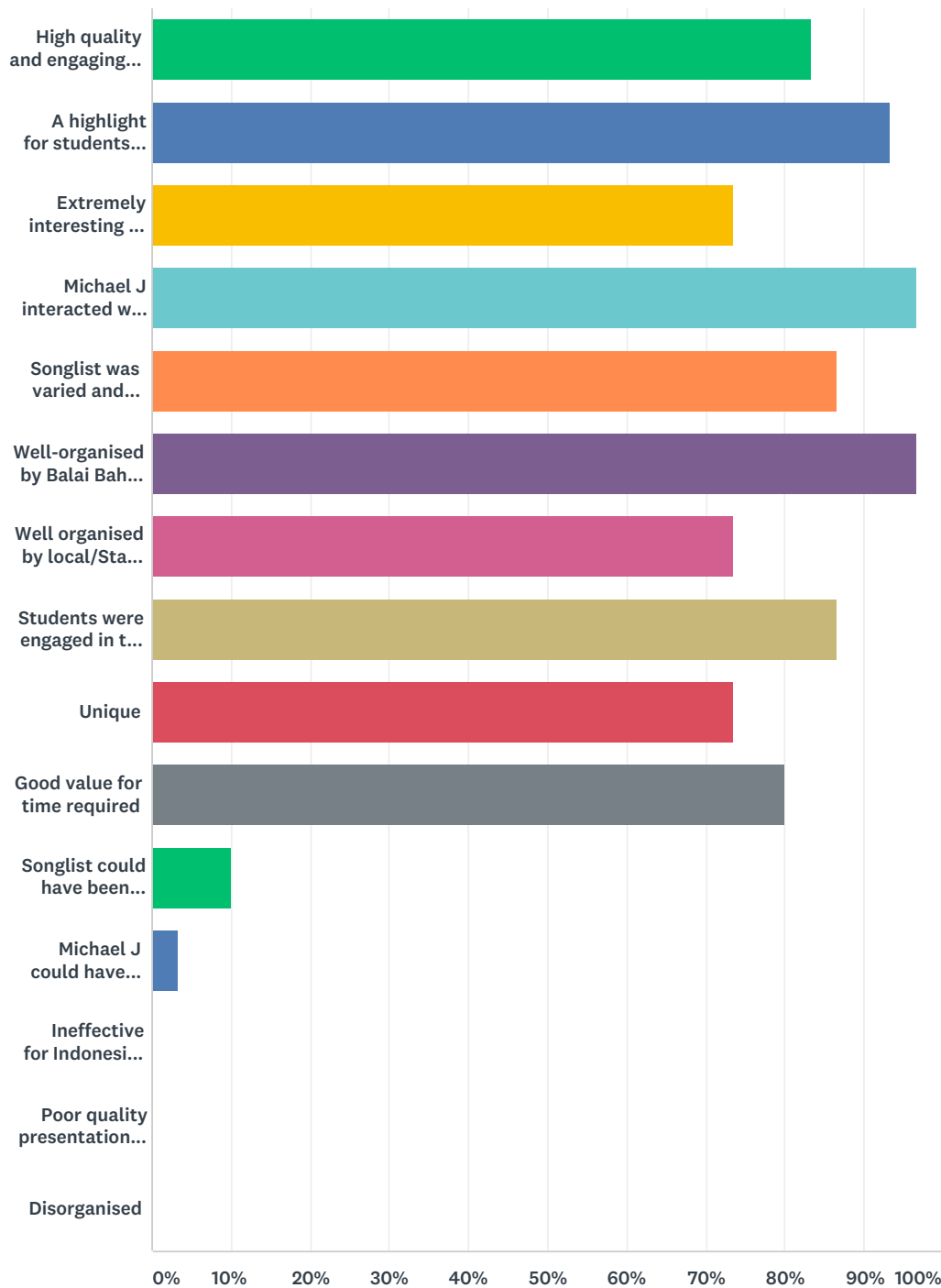

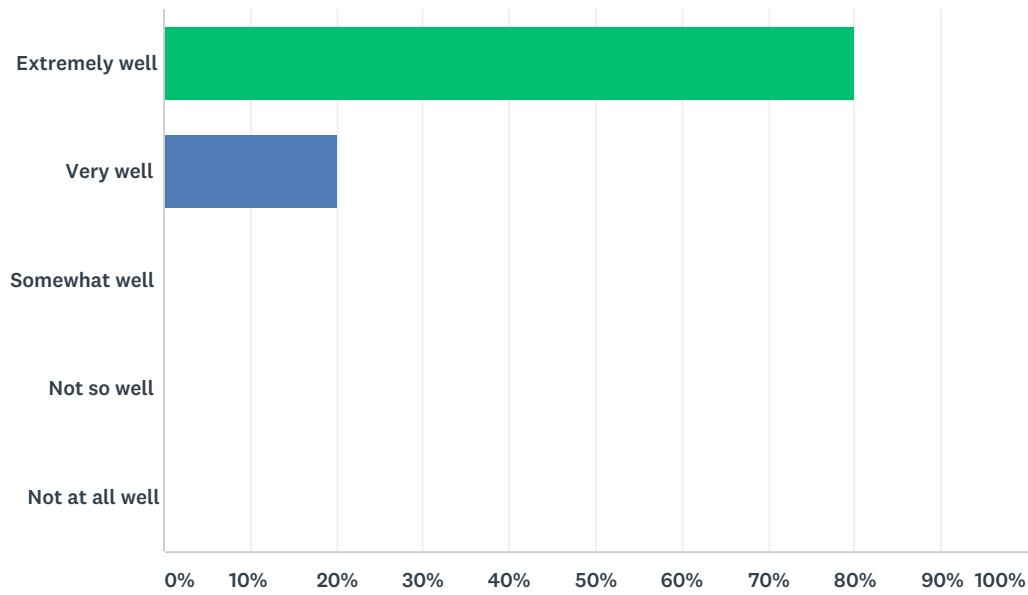

Q8 How well did the Michael J School Concert or visit meet your expectations?

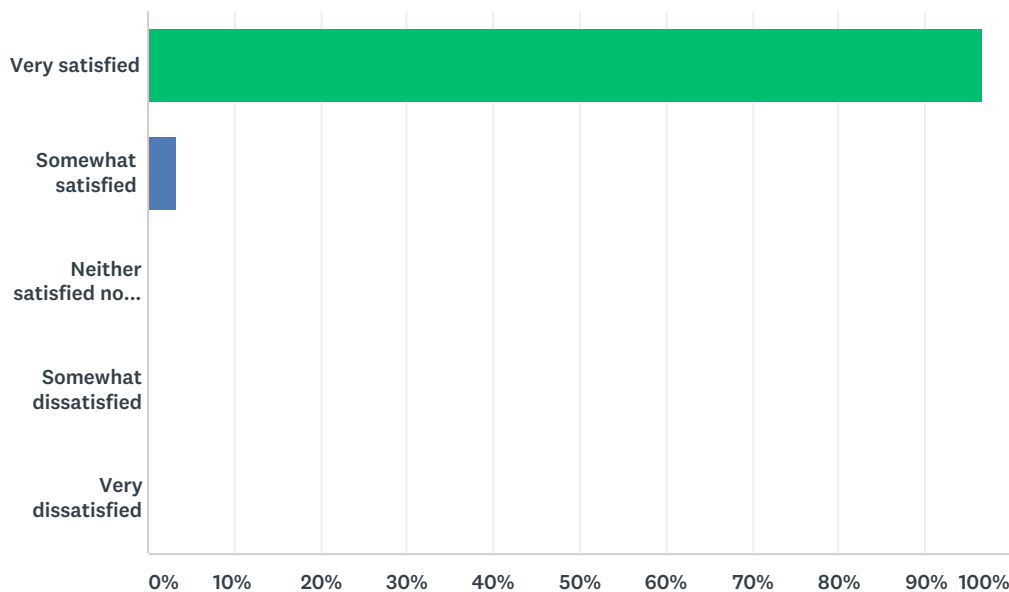

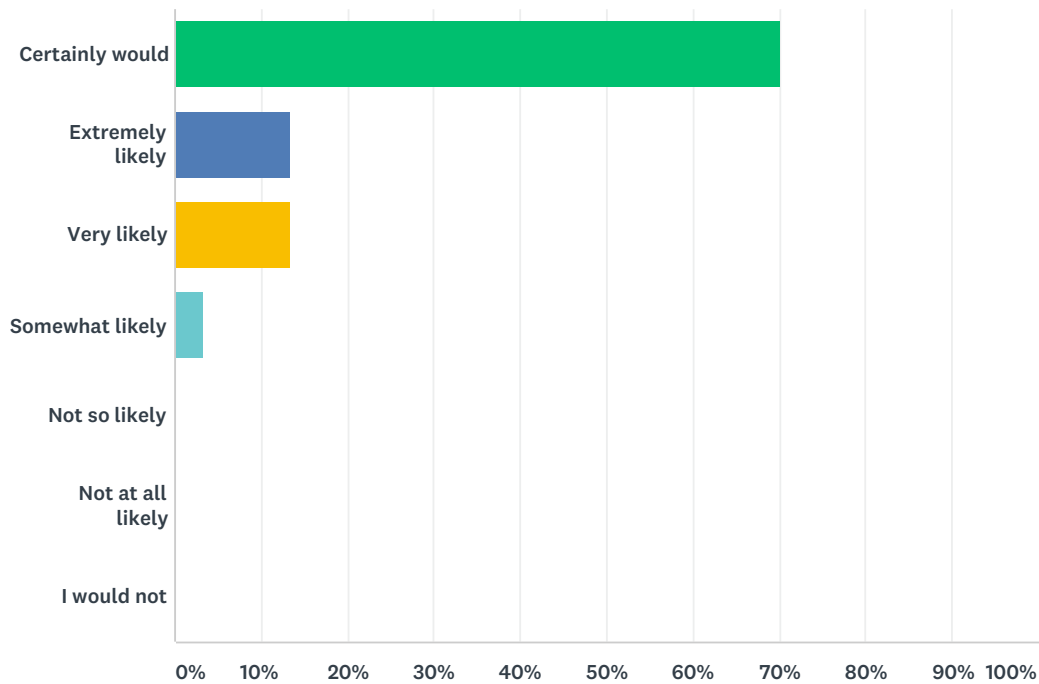
