REFUND AND WITHDRAWAL POLICIES

- No refund can be given for any classes missed or for withdrawal after the first lesson.

- Refunds for withdrawals before the commencement date will incur a \$20 administration fee. Refunds can only be made via electronic transfer so please include your bank details when making a withdrawal request.
